## **Regional Director's Report**

### **Introduction of Karen Owens:**

Karen Owens was introduced as the new Emergency Operations Division Director.

### **Upcoming Special Called GAB Meeting:**

A special meeting is scheduled for 10:00 AM on September 18, 2024.

### **Drug Box Restocking:**

Restocking procedures for drug boxes with Centra were discussed. The boxes will now be property of individual agencies, with BREMS and hospitals providing additional orange boxes.

### **Regional Med Kit Update:**

There was confusion from the FDA regarding changes to drug box procedures. Dr. Cohen mentioned that Campbell County requested epi kits, and Jenn Martin will send out CertiDose information to that specific agency to assist with rising costs of epi.

### **MCI Update & LU Pegasus Solutions:**

LU is fully funding next year's training exercise, and localities are working on EMS plans for the live drill.

### **Regional Blood Program Report:**

Mary Kathryn presented a report, outlining the cost of blood products and delivery:

- \$395 per unit
- \$1,100 shipping cost per month
- \$61,080 annual cost for blood products
- Michelle expressed hesitation about committing until further clarification on EMS's role. Danny Williams shared insights from LFD's blood program.

### **Handtevy:**

A motion was made to approve the Handtevy system for one year by Lisa Aiken and seconded by Michelle Turner. Motion carried unanimously.

### **Website:**

Lori Meadows reported that the new website has launched with an online registration for clinical students.

### **Training and Development:**

Training and Development has been set up for September, October and November with tentative trainings January -March. Trainings for 2024 include Pediatric Cardiology, Mechanical Ventilation Workshop, Tactical Resilience Workshop, Dementia, Tracheostomy Care and The Agitated Patient.

## New Business

- **Attorney Change:**  
Betsy Phillips, former attorney for the State Corp Commission, has retired. John Alford from Caskie and Frost will be the new attorney for BREMS.
- **Regional OMD Contract:**  
The contract for the regional operational medical director was discussed, with \$15,000 allocated for every six months. Karen Owens clarified that OEMS would not pay for OMD services, as it is not part of the contract.
- **Designation Process Deadline:**  
Karen Owens reported that the BREMS designation process is due by December 15, 2024. No changes are being made to the process currently.
- **Vector Solutions Online Training and Development Opportunities:**  
State Contract with Vector Solutions will be terminated effective December 31, 2024.
- **Regional and State Awards Program:**  
Dr. Cohen questioned the timing of an awards reception at 4:00 PM on a Monday. Mary Kathryn explained it was necessary due to limited resources. Karen Owens shared that the state is evaluating its awards program for the upcoming year.

### CISM (Critical Incident Stress Management):

There have been seven debriefs since January 2024, with new members joining the Tactical Resiliency program.
